Lent and Good Friday

The season of Lent continues for the first two weeks of April, culminating with Good Friday on Friday, April 18. Thank you to Roxane Wales for her excellent work making the sanctuary reflect this time of the Christian calendar. The Sundays of Lent continue through Palm Sunday on April 13. Palm Sunday will include the waving of palm branches and shouts of "Hosanna!" as we commemorate the triumphal entry of Christ into Jerusalem. On Good Friday, April 18, Bethany will open the doors of the sanctuary from 12-3 pm.. The congregation is invited to come by for a time of personal reflection and quiet, pondering the story of the crucifixion of Jesus Christ. Several stations will be set up with activities available for prayer and reflection. Please plan to attend.

- **Financial Trustees** Lyn reported. a) We discussed the financial arrangements with the Sikh community. b) Some people give their gifts to the church at the end of the year. They are very faithful. It was suggested that we could take money from savings in the expected donation amount and replace it with the end-of-year donation. c) There is money available for camperships.

Dave Wales is seeking out a new vendor as the original vendor did not work out, and 3) Install heat pump which includes also involves reviewing vendors.

- In progress: Room 9 clean-up continuation
- In progress: Kitchen update cleanup and cleanout
- In progress: On-line giving opportunities; Pastor Deb is working to move this forward
- Patio repair: On hold for now
- Upper roof repair: On hold for now
